OFFICE ORDER

Subject: **CONTINUATION OF ISSUANCE OF NEW OVERSEAS EMPLOYMENT
PROMOTER'S LICENSES**

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to state that owing to the growing demand for Pakistani HR abroad (un-skilled / semi-skilled / skilled) and in the light of scrutiny of existing OEP licenses regarding their performance and conduct and the resultant corrective measures, the issuance of new licenses would commence with immediate effect under the prescribed terms and conditions.

2. As a result of ongoing reforms in the regulatory regime, the revised terms and conditions in respect of OEP licenses, to be issued periodically, aim to safeguard the interest of potential emigrants, enhance the efficiency of emigration process, and meet the demands of overseas employers by facilitating recruitment at minimal cost and within a reasonable timeframe.

3. This issues with the approval of the Federal Minister for OP&HRD.
